## **ABSTRACT**

The PPM activity for regional development aims to provide knowledge and skills to leaders and Private Vocational Teachers to implement monitoring and evaluation electronically (E-Monev) so that it can improve the quality of services for educational activities in schools, especially in learning. The target of this activity is five teachers and leaders in 5 (five) Private Vocational Schools in Sleman Regency, Yogyakarta. The activities are carried out through four main stages, namely: (1) Mentoring to improve the skills of Teachers and Leaders in e-Monev, (2) Mentoring the development of e-Monev devices in each school, (3) Implementation of e-Monev in schools, especially for performance Teachers in learning, (4) Evaluating satisfaction and effectiveness of e-Monev implementation. Activities can take place as planned. Based on the questionnaire given to students, teachers, and leaders, in general school leaders and teachers were satisfied with the implementation of e-Monev in schools. According to the Teacher, with the existence of e-Monev, their performance in learning increased significantly. Likewise according to the leadership, and students, the implementation of e-Monev has a positive impact on improving the quality of learning.
