

Training on School-Based Management to build Principal Competency in Primary Schools in Depok District Education Office Sleman Regency

ABSTRACT

There is a demand on competent school principal for school success. The Community Service Program or program pengabdian pada masyarakat (PPM) in Indonesian term, was a response to it. It was held to provide training on school-based management to Principals in Depok District Education Office, Sleman Regency to strengthen their competence. The training focused on two areas, namely: 1) building harmonious relationships between parents and students; and 2) conflict management and creativity in decision-making.
