

# **INTERACTIVE-INTERACTIVE POWERPOINT SLIDE DEVELOPMENT TRAINING AS A LEARNING MEDIA FOR IPS TEACHERS OF MGMP, WONOGIRI DISTRICT**

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## **ABSTRACT**

Along with advances in technology and information, of course, the development of media is also growing rapidly. Ease of internet access, *browsing* data, pictures, movies, audio videos is easy things. The development of ICT-based learning is a must. PowerPoint is the easiest ICT-based presentation tool (learning media). Of the many learning media, PowerPoint media can be used and created by teachers themselves to make teaching and learning activities more interesting and lively. PowerPoint media can be made simply and not too difficult. This media can be produced by school teachers at a relatively affordable cost. In its operation, this media can be combined with music files, images and can be easily presented via the screen and LCD. The activity method chosen for the implementation of interactive-engaging PowerPoint slide development training service activities as a learning medium for Social Studies teachers at MGMP in Wonogiri Regency is a combination method of tutorials or lectures, discussions or questions and answers and independent practice and groups accompanied by resource persons from the team devotee through online non face to face. Based on the results of the assessment of an interactive-interesting PowerPoint slide script as a learning medium made by all PPM participants, the result is 60% in the very good category with a value above 85, 25% is in the good category with a value between 70 to 85 while 15% is categorized as sufficient with a score below 70. So it can be concluded that the PPM participants have understood the material presented by the Service Team. Based on the results of the PPM participant satisfaction questionnaire distributed by the Service Team as a form of evaluation of PPM activities, it was found that 80% were in the high category, 20% were in the high enough category and 0% were in a low category. So it can be concluded that PPM participants have high satisfaction with the workshop activities of the service team from Social Sciences Education in 2020.
