Comprehension and Implementation of Vision & Mission Of Graduate Program at Yogyakarta State University

ABSTRACT

This study aims to describe the understanding and implementing of vision and mission of Graduate Program at Yogyakarta State University.

Quantitative approach and survey method used in this study. The population is the existing magister student body i.e. 2.931 student; and the sample choose by random sampling technique with degree of confidence 95% was 341 students. Data were collected through questioners that were getting 231 from 341 students. The data analysis employed descriptive statistics. The study finding show that (1) the degree of understanding of PPs UNY vision and mission in sivitas academica PPs UNY was very good; (2) the degree of implementation the vision also very good, on values: exellence, pious, and intellect. Whereas autonom value is still at good category. (3) the degree of implementation of mission is good, with details in the good level for learning process, research and community services; and very good for education quality and its relevance. While the governance area is running good, with details: good for credibility, responsibility, and equity; and very good for transparancy and accountability.
