DEVELOPMENT OF TALENT IDENTIFICATION MODEL IN ATHLETIC FOR 12-15 YEARS IN THE SPECIAL REGION OF YOGYAKARTA

ABSTRACT

The purpose of this study is to develop a model of talent or talent identification at athletic. Specific objectives to be achieved: (1) Develop product in the form of test items of athletic sports talent measurement consisting of anthropometry test and motion test of children aged 12-15 years, (2) Developing talent identification book age 12-15 years athletic, and (3) Conduct a product trial. To achieve these targets, research is designed through research & development in five phases: (1) conducting analysis of products to be developed; (2) developing the initial product; (3) expert validation; (4) field trials; (5) product revisions. Research subjects to develop a talent identification test involve experts: (1) Athletic Coaching, and (2) Sports Tests and Measurements. Object test and measurement test in this study were students with age 12-15 years selected by purposive sampling in Province D.I. Yogyakarta a total of 250 people. The research instrument is an observation sheet or product evaluation sheet prepared by the researcher. Data analysis used descriptive statistics and variance analysis.
