STANDARDIZATION OF LITERACY COMPETENCE AND INFORMATION LITERACY COMPETENCE OF BASIC AND MIDDLE EDUCATION STUDENTS

ABSTRACT

Community Service entitled Standardization of Library Competence and Standardization Information Literacy, aims to: a) inspire the standardization of both because in the context of Education in Indonesia there is no support of these two standards in detail; b) support the school literacy movement.

Standardization is carried out with the following steps: a) searching for standardization used by countries whose literacy has been developed and established with the support of the administration system and its indicators in equipping the special abilities of the student related to reading matters; b) translate the two standards from English into Indonesian; c) conduct a cloze-reading of the results of a standardized translation with a limited sample of school teachers in grades 1-12 around the Yogyakarta Special Region in terms of content and conceptual understanding.

The expected output from this activity is the initial reading of both standards. Furthermore, the results are submitted to the Yogyakarta State University Library for the next stage of development. Suggestions that can be submitted are based on these findings, then a trial is suggested to conduct with a larger sample from the five Education administration regions in the Special Region of Yogyakarta.
