

SOCIALIZATION OF VIOLENCE PREVENTION IN THE WORLD OF MAYA (CYBERBULLYING) AND THE IMPACT OF USE OF TECHNOLOGY IN ADOLESCENT TEACHER IN STUDENT SMA NEGERI 1 DEPOK BABARSARI

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ABSTRACT

The purpose of this Community Service activity is a) to increase knowledge, understanding and appreciation about cyberbullying phenomenon in terms of the occurrence, prevention and ways of cyberbullying; b) enhance knowledge, understanding and appreciation of cyberbullying in terms of the ITE Law; c) Increase knowledge, understanding and appreciation about cyberbullying in terms of Child Protection Law on Vocational High School students at SMK I Negeri Kalasan Yogyakarta, d) Increase knowledge, understanding and appreciation about the impact of technology for high school students.

This community service activity is done by lecture, question and answer method, discussion and identifying issues related to cyberbullying and problem solving. The target of PPM is high school students that is all the students of SMA Negeri I Depok Babarsari Yogyakarta number of 70 participants. Implementation of this PPM on Saturday, October 1, 2017, in the Hall of SMA Negeri I Depok. The activities in the first session were filled with the presentation of material about the Cyberbullying phenomenon in terms of their occurrence, prevention and mitigation measures, understanding of cyberbullying in terms of the ITE Act, then understanding the cyberbullying in terms of Child Protection Act and the latest material on Knowledge of Cyberbullying and its prevention methods such violence among teenagers. The material is delivered by lecture and question and answer method. The second sessions of the students were given the task of identifying the cases and then continued with the discussion so that the participants had the ability to solve the problems related to cyberbullying phenomenon and cyberbullying control in terms of the ITE Law and Child Protection Act among the Students. The second material is delivered by the method of discussion and problem solving of the case identification.

This devotion activity can be said to run well and smoothly, but there are still some limitations in its implementation. High school students as participants of the socialization were less enthusiastic and less enthusiastic in following the sessions, both material exposure, question and answer and discussion. In addition, the results of the participants' exposure and discussion of the simulated cases indicate an increase in the participants' level of knowledge and understanding of the material.
