

The Training of Children's Fine Art Techniques for Elementary School Teachers in Bantul

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ABSTRACT

The goal to be achieved from this training activity is to train elementary school teachers in Yogyakarta about various children's art techniques so that adequate competency is achieved so that learning is more quality and meaningful.

The training activities of various techniques for children's art work for elementary school teachers were carried out using the Lecture, Discussion and Practice methods independently by the guidance of the implementing team.

The training was attended by 30 primary school teachers in Bantul and lasted for 2 days. Participants were very enthusiastic in participating in training from beginning to end. From the results of the training it can be seen that the participants have mastered the art techniques taught, including two-dimensional and three-dimensional art techniques, materials and tools needed and procedures for making works. The material presented can be received, digested and understood by the participants well. The number of participants that is comparable to the number of servants (5:30) makes this training more conducive. The activities take place smoothly, on time and as expected and the participants feel the benefits of the activities.
