## Workshop on Development of Mathematical Literacy Questions for Junior High School Mathematics Teachers in Kulon Progo Regency

## **ABSTRACT**

The Community Service Activities (PPM) with the title "Workshop on Development of Mathematical Literacy Questions for Junior High School Mathematics Teachers in Kulon Progo Regency" aims to improve the quality of junior high school mathematics teaching and learning activities in Kulon Progo Regency. More specifically, this PPM activity seeks to enhance the skills of mathematics teachers in developing or compiling math literacy questions.

The target of this activity is at least 50 junior high school mathematics teachers in Kulon Progo Regency. The PPM team invited 75 junior high school mathematics teachers in Kulon Progo Regency who actively participated in MGMP activities. There were 73 people present on the first day, and 66 people on the second day.. The PPM activity took place at Junior High School 1 Wates, Kulon Progo. This activity carried out on 8 and 15 August 2019.

The PPM activities are in the form of workshops, which include theoretical, practical, and presentation activities. Practical activities to make math literacy problems can be done well. However, to be able to compile various literacy questions with diverse processes, content and contexts, some teachers still face difficulties. For the upcoming PPM activities, some workshop participants suggested giving a workshop on developing innovative learning models.
