TRAINING OF EVENT-BASED INSTRUCTIONAL MODEL FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHERS AND CANDIDATE

ABSTRACT

The event-based instructional model in Physical Education has not been well implemented in schools. In fact, this model has a multiplicity in collaborative teacher and student involvement. Therefore, this Community Service (CS) program is needed that aims to provide knowledge and skills regarding the application of event-based instructional model through training and mentoring activities. The CS is collaborating with lecturers and students from Osaka Sangyo University, Japan and PT. Otsuka Indah Amerta. The audience for this activity is 770 people including teachers, students (grades 1st-6th), parents of students of Giwangan and Kota Gede 1 Elementary School, Teacher Candidate, and invited guests. The training activities in this CS were carried out on Wednesday February 6, 2019 at Faculty of Sport Sciences, while the assistance was carried out on Thursday-Saturday, February 7 - 9, 2019 at the Karang Gede Field and School. These CS activities have succeeded in providing knowledge and skills about the event-based instructional model to teachers and teacher's candidate (students) as well as students and parents who are actively involved in the application of the model. CS involving collaboration from foreign has provided valuable learning for the service team and audience about the importance of managerial, individual, and social responsibilities.
