ABSTRACT

Community Service Activities with the theme of Financial Literacy Counseling To Improve Financial Skills and Financial Knowledge for school Teenagers, held at SMA N 6 Yogyakarta, aimed to provide insights about financial literacy to teenagers, especially high school students. Community Service Activities that aim to provide knowledge about financial products and types of investment in the community were expected by participants to have good financial planning in the future; they would not get caught up in the wrong investments and fraudulent financial products.

This activity was carried out by lecturing, audio-visual and question-and-answer questions regarding financial literacy for young teenagers. The materials were given around financial planning in order to reach the future and the types or investment products that offered through many internet networks.
