## **GUIDANCE AND COUNSELING AT PRIMARY SCHOOL LEVEL**

## **ABSTRACT**

The problem experienced by partners is that guidance and counseling services are currently handled directly by class teachers or subject teachers, so that these teachers have a dual role as class or subject teachers, as well as guidance and counseling teachers. The aim of this community service is to provide insight into guidance and counseling as a basis for services to students for FIPP UNY Laboratory Pedagogy Elementary School teachers.
