VOCATIONAL GUIDANCE PATTERN FOR VOCATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT GROUP THROUGH A NETWORK SYSTEM IN THE MIDDLE OF PANDEMI COVID 19

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ABSTRACT

This study aims to produce a pattern of vocational guidance for groups of vocational students through an online system that is appropriate, has an adequate level of feasibility, and knows student responses to the implementation of group vocational guidance patterns. This study uses a research and development method with the ADDIE model approach from Robert Maribe Branch, which consists of Analyze, Develop, Implementation, and Evaluation. The subjects of this study were students of class XI, the Department of Electrical Engineering, SMKN 3 Yogyakarta. The research data was taken using a questionnaire method, via google form. The research data were analyzed using qualitative descriptive techniques. The results showed that the pattern of group vocational guidance for vocational students using the online system had been successfully developed, with the feasibility level being included in the very feasible category (87.50%), and getting responses from students, in the fairly good category (43.75%).
